## General

Play will be governed by FIFA Laws of the Game. AYSO National Rules and Regulations. Area 4U Interregional Guidelines and specific Tournament Rules.

The Area 4U tournament is considered one tournament scheduled over several weeks. Therefore any individual player may play in only one division.

## Team and Player Eligibility

Only regular season AYSO teams created during fall or spring of the current season are eligible for this tournament. Combined, elite, or select teams are not permitted. **NO GUEST PLAYERS.**

All players must be registered in an AYSO region on or before Sept. 1 in order to be eligible for this tournament. Players not registered by Sept 1 will not be allowed to participate in this tournament.

*Only players listed on the team's regular season roster, approved by the Regional Commissioner and the Area 4U Tournament Committee will be eligible to play in the tournament. If an ineligible player plays for a team in any part of a tournament game, the team will be disqualified from the tournament; and all games will be deemed forfeited. Rosters must be signed by RC.*

## Coaches Training

All coaches should have taken the AYSO Age Specific training. Coaches and assistant coaches **must** take the AYSO Safe Haven course. Coaches **must** also have medical release forms for all of their players at all games and provide same if asked to do so by the referee for any game or by a tournament committee member for any game.

## Conduct of Players, Coaches, and Spectators

Good sportsmanship and clean competition shall be encouraged by coaches.

Coaches, Parents, and Players shall conduct themselves in a manner becoming a member of the American Youth Soccer Organization.

Coaches are responsible for controlling the conduct and sideline behavior of the players, parents and assistant coaches at the tournament.

**There is to be no coaching from the spectators.**

## Substitutions and Game Times

Substitutions will be made only per AYSO National Rules and Regulations. Goalkeepers in Under 12 may only play ½ of a game. Goalkeepers in U14 and U19 may play for a full game.

Game times will be:

Regular time for U5/U6

10 minute halves for Under 8

15 minute halves for Under 10

20 minute halves for Under 12

25 minute halves for Under 14

30 minute halves for Under 19

## Weather

In case of inclement weather or unplayable field conditions, the Tournament Committee may take any of the following actions: Delay play for a period of time, reduce game times to catch up the schedule, reschedule games, cancel or reschedule the tournament. Awards may not be awarded if play is not completed in any age group. Team deposits will be returned if event gets cancelled.

## Team Volunteer

All teams which enter the jamboree or tournament must provide one adult to work as a volunteer. AYSO is an all volunteer organization and will need assistance in the operations of this event.

## U-05 - U-10 Jamboree

Teams will be allowed to remain together for this event. The AYSO tournament staff will balance playing pools to ensure a fun time for all.

Each registered team will have a minimum of a 2/3 game playing schedule.

## Fees

**There will be no fees associated with this Jamboree or Tournament.**

**A \$50.00 refundable deposit will be required at the time of registration.**
