Rules of the game: *FIFA rules apply if not modified within* The following rules have been designed to ensure fair play for all participants. Each player is expected to understand these rules prior to their participation in the tournament. Any questions concerning these rules should be directed to the AYSO Tournament Staff.

Teams will be placed into divisions based upon age and gender. Any team or player determined by the Tournament Director to have falsified age or division level will be dismissed from the tournament. Teams that span more than one age group will be placed into the division of the oldest player on the team.

RULES: Will be located on area website: www.ayso4U.org

Number of Players: Five is the maximum number of players on a team: three field players and two substitutes. Players may only play on one team per division. There are no goal keepers in 3 v 3.

Coach Qualifications: All coaches and assistant coaches must have current AYSO volunteer forms, successfully completed AYSO Safe Haven course. All head coaches must be age specifically trained prior to submitting registration for this event. It shall be the sole responsibility of the home region of each team to ensure that all coaches participating in this event have met these minimum requirements. This tournament staff will review via E-AYSO qualification and training histories of all participating coaches prior to accepting team registrations for this event.

Player Registration: All players must be registered prior to their first scheduled game time. Teams cannot add player after their first game has been started. Tournament officials have the right to demand proof of age for any player included on the roster. Coaches must have in their possessions current player registration (medical treatment) forms and be able to show them upon request.

Weather: In case of inclement weather or unplayable field conditions. The Tournament Committee may take any of the following actions: Delay play for a period of time, reschedule games, cancel or reschedule the tournament.

Awards may not be awarded if play is not completed in any age group. If event gets cancelled it will be scheduled the following week. Please review Weather Related issues in the tournament rules for further information

Fees: Entry fees will be \$75.00 per team. Refund requests submitted in writing to the tournament director will be accepted up to October 30th . NO Exceptions.
